## What is it?

The Orange County Planning Department, in partnership with the Orange County Land Trust, is updating the Countywide Open Space Plan. The overall goal is to promote continued awareness of the County's valuable open space resources, identify where and how these spaces are currently protected and where there is a need to preserve additional lands, and improve public access points. The Plan will also address the environmental, health, and economic benefits of open space and increasing access to those benefits. By outlining areas where significant open space resources are located, and critical corridors that preserve connectivity, municipalities and other interested stakeholders can use this tool to inform their planning efforts and apply the recommended strategies.

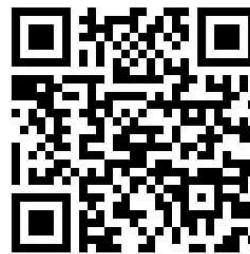
